Some background information on Dr Keryln Carville who will be presenting the classes:

Keryln is the Associate Professor of Domiciliary Nursing at Silver Chain Nursing Association and Curtin University. In addition, she fulfills the role of Clinical Nurse Consultant in Stomal Therapy and Wound Management. Keryln has an expansive clinical practice in wound and ostomy management and has an ongoing commitment to research and education within these domains.

Silver Chain is the largest home nursing agency in Western Australia and Keryln has a joint position at Curtin University of Technology for the development and coordination of postgraduate programs in domiciliary nursing.

Keryln is a Founding and Life Member of the Western Australia Wound Care Association. She was admitted as an Inaugural Fellow of the Australian Wound Management Association (AWMA) in 2006. Keryln is Chairperson of the AWMA Subcommittee for the development and review of Australian Standards of Wound Management, Chairperson of the Australian Pressure Ulcer Advisory Panel (APUAP) and a member of the AWMA Venous Leg Ulcer Committee (VLUC). In addition, she sits on the Editorial Board for Primary Intention and the Journal of Stomal Therapy Australia and is a member of the WoundsWest© Executive project team. The latter WA Health Department initiative is a key program under the reform package of Ambulatory Care and Chronic Disease Management. This year, Keryln was the proud recipient of the Nurses Board of WA "Community Nurse/Midwife of the Year Award" at the recent 2007 WA Nursing and Midwifery Excellence Awards.
